

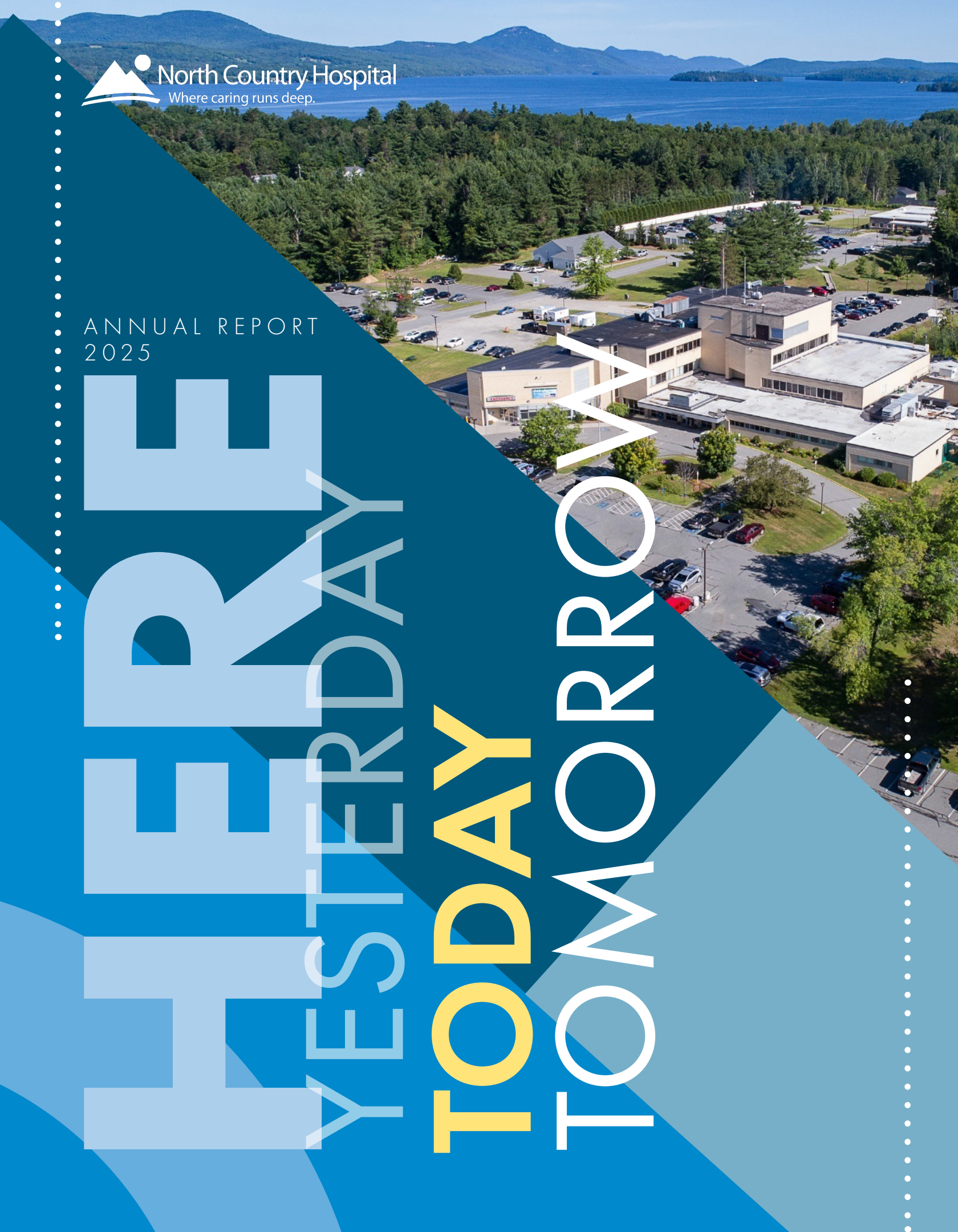

Three New Additions Strengthening Care at North Country Hospital

At North Country Hospital, innovation and compassion go hand in hand. Every investment we make in new technology has one goal, to provide the people of the Northeast Kingdom with the very best care, close to home. This year, the Imaging Department proudly introduced three state-of-the-art systems that are already transforming the patient experience and improving diagnostic precision: the Genius 3D Dimensions Mammography System, an enlarged Signa MRI, and a GE Logic Ultrasound unit. “These upgrades aren’t just about machines,” says Dr. Steven Rinehouse, Radiologist at North Country Hospital. “They’re about giving our patients access to the same technology you’d find in major medical centers, right here in our community. When we can offer earlier detection, greater comfort, and faster results, everyone benefits.”



“The comfort factor is huge,” says Dr. Rinehouse. “A wider opening means patients can relax more, which in turn helps us get better images. The new Signa system also delivers sharper, faster scans so our patients spend less time in the scanner and we get the highest quality images for diagnosis.”



With its advanced capabilities, the Signa Artist MRI helps physicians diagnose a wide range of conditions, from musculoskeletal injuries to neurological and vascular disorders—with remarkable clarity. It’s technology that helps shorten the path between a symptom and a solution.



A Community Commitment to Quality Care

Each of these new imaging systems represents more than an upgrade, it’s a promise to our community. These investments strengthen North Country Hospital’s ability to provide exceptional care, enhance patient comfort, and ensure that cutting-edge diagnostics are always available locally.

“Every time we add technology like this,” says Dr. Rinehouse, “we’re reminding our community that they don’t have to travel hours away for world-class care. They can get it right here, surrounded by people they know and trust.”

At North Country Hospital, we believe that the best care is local care—made stronger through innovation, compassion, and a commitment to the future of health in the Northeast Kingdom.

Genius 3D Dimensions Mammography: Seeing the Smallest Details

When it comes to breast health, early detection makes all the difference. The new Genius 3D Dimensions Mammography System offers a revolutionary way to detect cancer earlier and more accurately. By capturing multiple images of the breast from various angles, it creates a highly detailed three-dimensional picture that helps radiologists see beyond overlapping tissue.

“3D mammography has changed the way we detect breast cancer,” explains Dr. Rinehouse. “It allows us to find cancers that might be hidden in traditional 2D images and reduces unnecessary callbacks for additional views. That means less anxiety for patients and more confidence in their results.”

This system also features a more comfortable, curved compression surface for some patients, one designed to reduce discomfort during screening. It’s a small change that makes a big difference, especially for women who might otherwise delay their annual mammogram.

Enlarged Signa Artist MRI: Comfort Meets Clarity

North Country Hospital’s newly enlarged Signa Artist MRI suite is another step forward in patient-centered imaging. The larger bore opening and improved design provide a more comfortable, less confined experience, something especially appreciated by patients who may experience claustrophobia during traditional MRI exams.

GE Logic Ultrasound: Precision in Real Time

The hospital’s new GE Logic Ultrasound system enhances how providers can visualize everything from developing pregnancies to heart and vascular function. Its real-time imaging, high-definition resolution, and adaptable tools mean faster, clearer answers for both patients and providers.

“Our ultrasound team loves this machine,” Dr. Rinehouse says with a smile. “It’s responsive, fast, and produces stunning images that help us make immediate, informed decisions. Whether we’re assessing a patient in the emergency department or following a baby’s growth, we can trust what we see.”

In addition, we are now offering Elastography of the liver which is a test used to check the elasticity of the liver. It can help healthcare providers diagnose liver disease and help stage certain conditions such as liver fibrosis.

Specialized Colorectal Surgery — Right Here in Newport

Diseases of the colon, rectum, and anus can significantly impact a patient's daily life. Dr. Kelley brings a depth of knowledge and state-of-the-art treatment options that help restore comfort, confidence, and health. His specialized colorectal services include:

- Colon and rectal cancer surgery with a focus on preserving function and promoting survivorship
- Anorectal procedures to treat painful conditions such as fistulas, hemorrhoids, and fissures
- Advanced diagnostics and polyp removal, including innovative colonoscopy techniques to prevent cancer
- Complex inflammatory bowel disease care, including surgical treatment for Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis
- Transanal Minimally Invasive Surgery (TAMIS) for precise tumor removal with faster recovery
- Rectal prolapse repair to restore stability and quality of life
- Diverticulitis surgery tailored to each patient's needs

Expanded General Surgery Capabilities

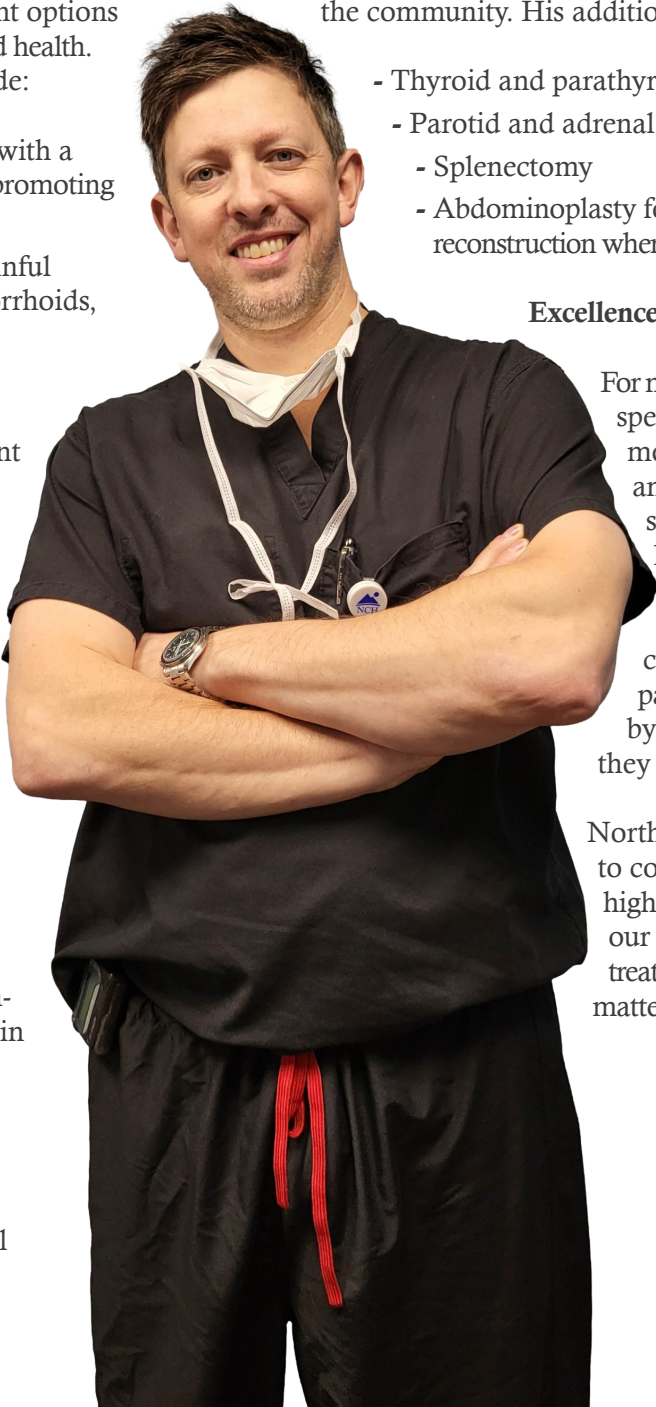
Dr. Kelley also provides an extended range of general surgical procedures, strengthening access to care within the community. His additional expertise includes:
